



much-loved farm shop on the outskirts of Llangrannog, enjoy seasonal fresh produce grown and reared at their very own farm.

A family-owned farm for over 100 years, this incredible team still farm in a traditional, sustainable, non-intensive way, with the highest standards of animal welfare at the heart of all that they do, resulting in the best quality food and produce.

Their shop is situated in a beautiful converted barn and they stock all kinds of amazing produce, such as eggs, meat, fruit, vegetables and honey. They also have a lovely selection of locally made organic cow and sheeps milk cheese, as well as local artisan organic bread, cakes, butter and yoghurt. They also sell cooked meats and other savouries such as pork pies and bakes, perfect for summer picnics.

With BBQ season on its way, its time for some award-winning meats, such as their grass fed beef, pork, lamb, chicken, duck and turkey. The farm also produce their much-loved bbq boxes, perfect for summer evenings, dining outdoors. As well as the classics, the farm also produces their own range of beef sausages, from traditional flavours to summery harrisa.

The farm shop provides a bespoke pre-ordering service on all their beef options, from an eighth of a steer taster box, casserole pack, to a specific joint or cut for a special occasion. Lamb and pork boxes are also available as well as their BBQ boxes and breakfast boxes. Pre-ordering gives you the opportunity to have your meat posted out overnight, fresh instead of frozen.



hether you're a Pembrokeshire visitor or local who has always wanted to try surfing or build on your existing skills, Blue Horizons is a surf school that welcomes everyone.

Blue Horizons Coastal Adventures CIC (Not-For-Profit) has become one of Pembrokeshire's most inclusive and community-focused surf providers. Born from a belief that the sea should be for everyone, they have made it their mission to offer high-quality, affordable, and meaningful coastal experiences to people of all ages and abilities.

Committed to small-group learning and a high instructor-to-surfer ratio, this approach isn't just about safety or logistics – it's about connection, confidence building and fast progression.

A team passionate about watersports, Blue Horizons started with a simple goal: to encourage more people into the water. Through their friendly, relaxed surf lessons, held at some of Pembrokeshire's most iconic beaches, Freshwater West, Manorbier, and Broad Haven North, this not-for-profit organisation has introduced hundreds of children, young people, and adults to the joy of surfing.

Their weekly kids' clubs have been a particular highlight. The team has supported many children who have never touched a surfboard before, some of whom are now regular riders, catching green waves and looking to take part in local surf competitions. Parents consistently share how the lessons have helped their children build resilience

and self-esteem. One parent described their son's first surf session as:

"the first time in months we'd seen him smile like that."

Blue Horizons is also proud to be part of the growing movement for inclusive and adaptive surfing in the UK. Following the introduction of the UK's first Adaptive Surfing qualification and training, our team is now formally qualified, enabling us to offer safe, supportive and empowering surf experiences for people with disabilities, neurodivergence, and complex needs.

Through community partnerships and local authority support, Blue Horizons has provided tailored surf lessons using the latest adaptive equipment – including beach wheelchairs, seated surfboards, surfboards with handles, tandem surfboards and soft-top boards designed for extra stability. These sessions are carefully designed with the guidance of families and carers to ensure each participant gets the level of support they need. For some, the experience is about floating in the sea for the first time; for others, it's the thrill of catching a wave with an instructor. These moments are powerful, for families as much as for the surfers themselves.

"We never thought surfing would be possible," said one parent, "but Blue Horizons made it feel safe, accessible, and joyful."

Blue Horizons also offers adaptive surf lessons to visitors of the region from across the UK, perfect for those who are looking for inclusive adventures.

2 hour evening Skomer & Shearwater Trip

ead out to Skomer Island, home to 35,000 Puffins then, witness the return of thousands of shearwaters to their burrows as dusk approaches.

Adult £65 Child £45 Private Charter £620

This trip runs from April to the end of July, subject to demand and weather. The puffins have left Skomer by the beginning of August. It is suitable for all ages 5 and above, but please feel free to contact us if you have any concerns.

Combine the delights of 2 of our most popular trips to see Pembrokeshire's most iconic seabird species, the Puffin and the Shearwater.

On this eveing trip we head out across St Brides Bay to the island of Skomer, home to over 46,000 Puffins (in 2025), 360,000 pairs of Manx shearwaters and the only Marine Conservation Zone in Wales. Sit in the tranquil waters of Skomer harbour watching the antics of the charismatic, technicolour Puffins as well as their larger cousins, the Guillemots and Razorbills, and learn about the flora, fauna and history of Skomer.

As we return across the bay you will witness one of the wonders of the natural world, as up to 360,000 Manx shearwater return to their burrows at dusk. The evening light on the islands is a photographer's dream, but the real experience to be sought after is when we sit with the engines off, marvelling at the tranquil gliding flight of the shearwaters as they swoop around us, wingtips skimming the surface of the sea or rafting up off the islands as the sun sets. This trip provides the perfect end to the perfect day in Pembrokeshire.

You can also expect close encounters with seals and possibly some of our resident Harbour porpoise or even if we're lucky some common dolphin, which regularly frequent St Brides Bay.






What You Can Expect to See

You can expect to see large numbers of the bright billed Puffins as well as Guillemots, Razorbills and Kittiwakes. There are many other resident birds, such as Oystercatchers, Shags and Cormorants, as well as the rare Chough and Peregrine falcon which may be seen. Year-round we are fortunate to enjoy the company of the Atlantic Grey seal which can often be seen in the harbour and along the coastline at Skomer. We also regularly encounter our pod of Harbour porpoise as they feed in the tidal waters of the Sound and sometimes we are treated to amazing sightings of Common dolphins.






